

Saunders's Factory

Little is known about Saunders's Factory except that it was owned by a William L. Saunders. It was located on the corner of Fourth and Main.

James Monroe Lanford died of disease at Saunders's Factory on December 28, 1862. Lanford was a 26-year-old Farmer from Farmersville, Alabama and served in Company A of the 44th Alabama Infantry. He is buried in Old City Cemetery in Lynchburg.
